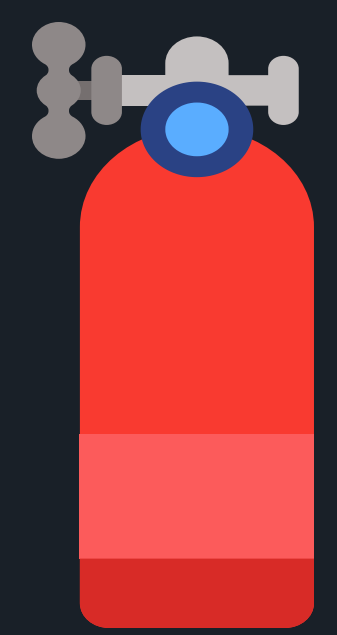


DON'T

Upgrade to N95 mask



Don't use high-flow O2 (including Bipap, Nebs, high flow nasal, ++L/min)



Wear fluid-resistant gown, standard gloves, & face shield



Don't allow non-critical staff in room



Use negative-pressure isolation room



Don't bag patient (if possible)



Use Rapid Sequence Intubation



Don't prolong intubation attempt (most qualified, quickest technique)



Don't bring used PPE outside the room
